

MUTTON MONTHLY REPORT



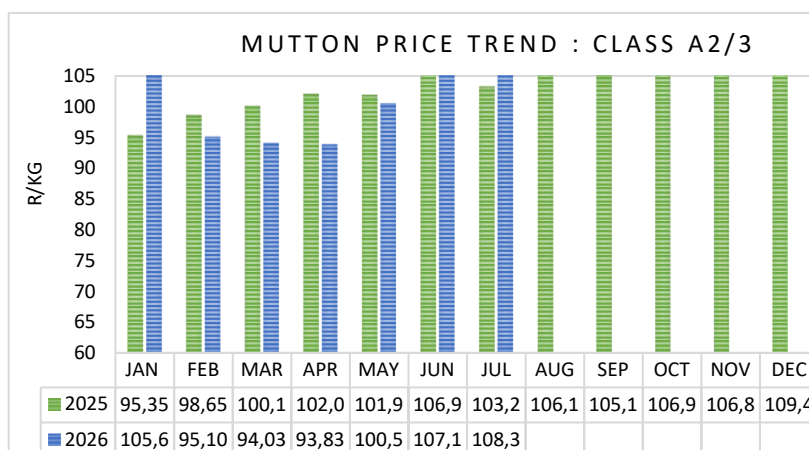
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This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer prices (R/kg) of mutton and feeder lambs excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Mutton - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

In July 2026, average local prices for mutton increased from prices recorded in June 2026. When comparing year on year prices, there is an increase in local prices for mutton in July 2026 compared to the same period last year.



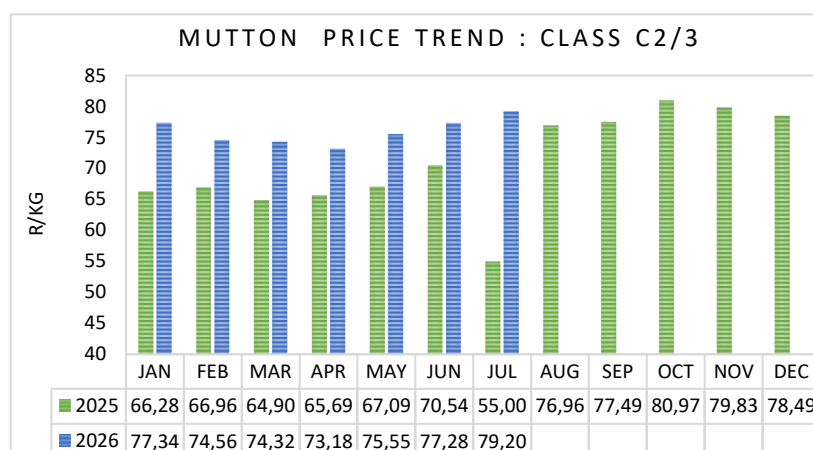
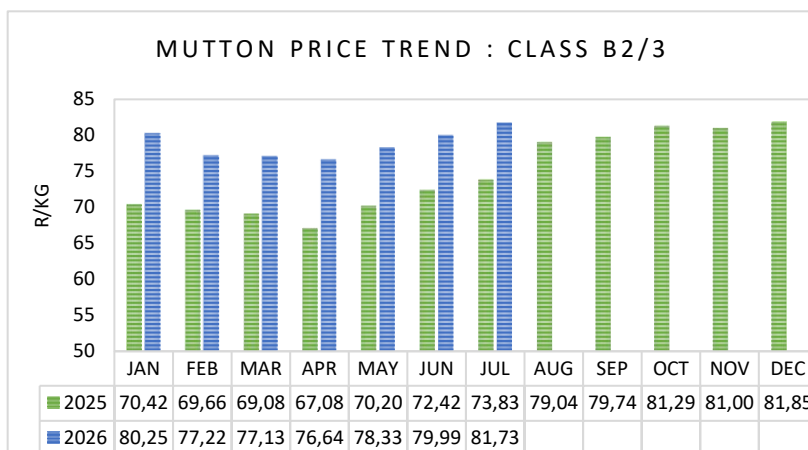
Class A2/3 Price trend

○ In July 2026, the average price for Class A Mutton was R108,39 per kg which is 1,2% higher than in June 2026.

○ Year on year average prices for Class A increased by 5% in July 2026 compared to July 2025.

Class B2/3 Price trend

- In July 2026, the average price for mutton Class B was R81,73 per kg, which is 2,2% higher than in June 2026.
- Year on year average prices for Class B were 10,7% higher than last year during the same period.

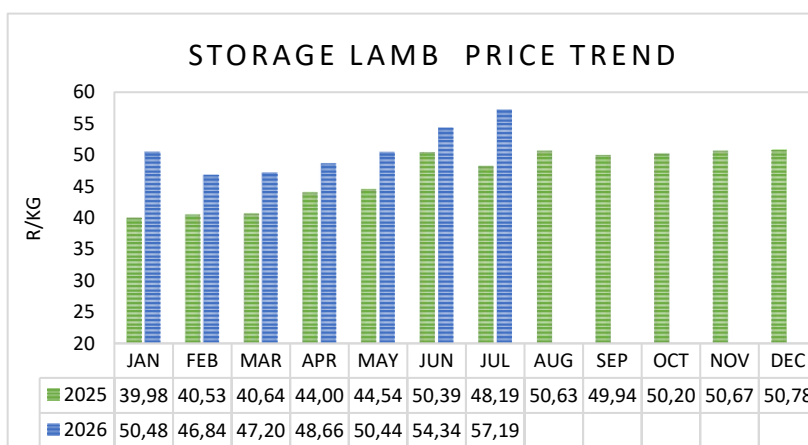


Class C2 / 3 Price trend

- In July 2026, the average price for Class C was R79,20 per kg, which is a 2,5% increase when compared to June 2026.
- Year on year Class C prices increased by 44% in July 2026 compared to July 2025.

Storage Lamb Price trend

- In July 2026, the average price for Storage Lamb was R57,19 per kg, which is 5,2% higher than in June 2026.
- Year on year average prices in July 2026 were 18,7% higher than last year during the same period.



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
