

GOAT MONTHLY REPORT



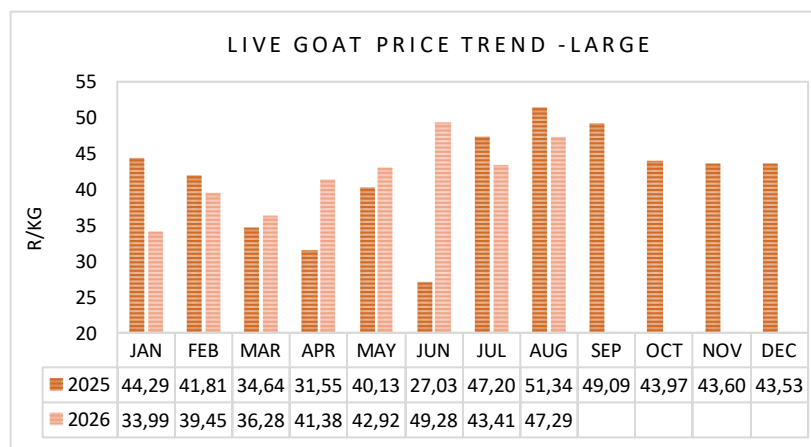
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This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of live goats excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Live goat- Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

In August 2026, average local prices for live goats increased (Except Small and Medium goat prices) from prices recorded in July 2026. When comparing year on year prices, there was a decrease (Except Medium goat prices) in local goats' prices in August 2026 compared to August 2025.

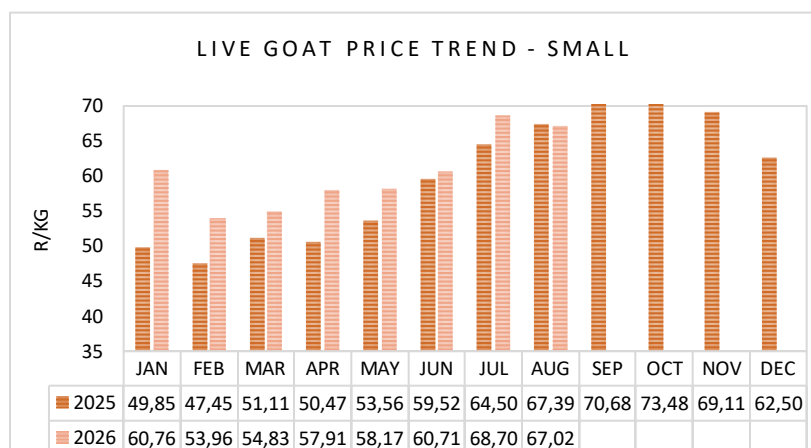
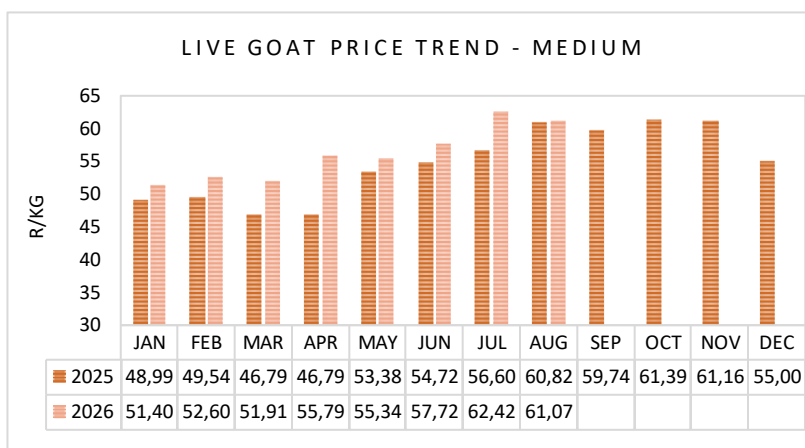


Large goat price trend

- In August 2026, the average price for a large goat was R47,29 per kg, which is 8,9% higher than in July 2026.
- Large goat prices decreased by 7,9% in August 2026 compared to August 2025.

Medium goat price trend

- In August 2026, the average price for a medium goat was R61,07 per kg, which is 2,2% price decrease from July 2026.
- Year on year average prices for a medium goat increased by 0,4% between August 2025 and August 2026.

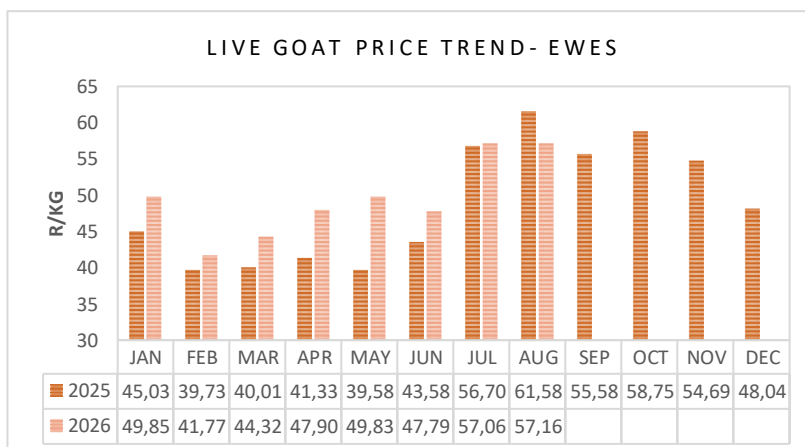


Small goat price trend

- During August 2026, average price for small goats was R67,02 per kg, which is a 2,4% price decrease from July 2026.
- Year on year small goat prices showed an average 0,6% decrease compared to the same period last year.

Live goat price trend (Ewes)

- In August 2026, the average price for Ewes was R57,16 per kg, which is 0,2% higher than in July 2026.
- Year on year average prices in August 2026 were 7,2% lower than the previous year.



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
