

MUTTON MONTHLY REPORT



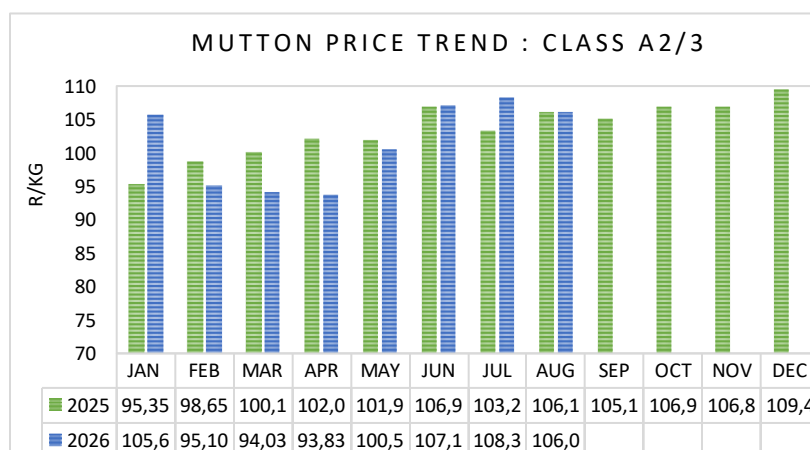
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This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer prices (R/kg) of mutton and feeder lambs excluding value added tax.

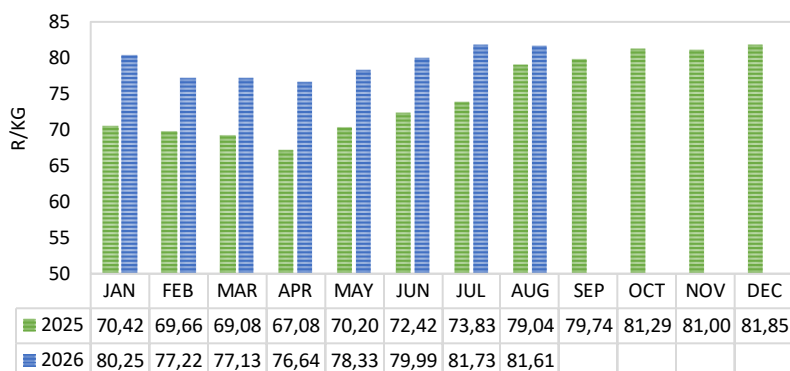
In August 2026, average local prices for mutton decreased (except Storage lamb) from prices recorded in July 2026. When comparing year on year prices, there is an increase (except Class A) in local prices for mutton in August 2026 compared to the same period last year.



Class A2/3 Price trend

- In August 2026, the average price for Class A Mutton was R106,09 per kg which is 2,1% lower than in July 2026.
- Year on year average prices for Class A decreased by 0,1% in August 2026 compared to August 2025.

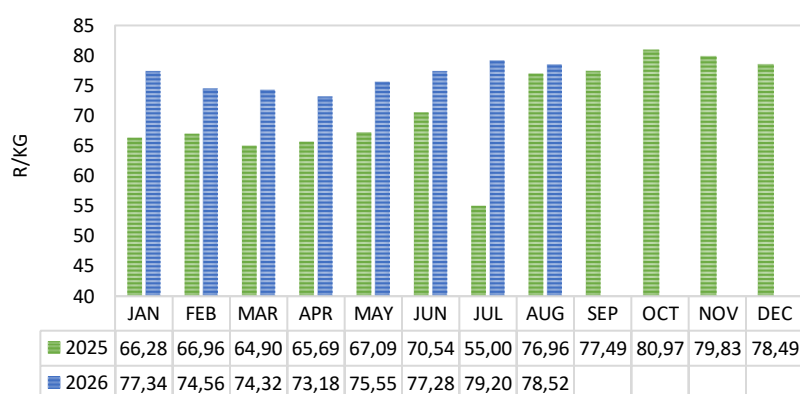
MUTTON PRICE TREND : CLASS B2/3



Class B2/3 Price trend

- In August 2026, the average price for mutton Class B was R81,61 per kg, which is 0,1% lower than in July 2026.
- Year on year average prices for Class B were 3,3% higher than last year during the same period.

MUTTON PRICE TREND : CLASS C2/3



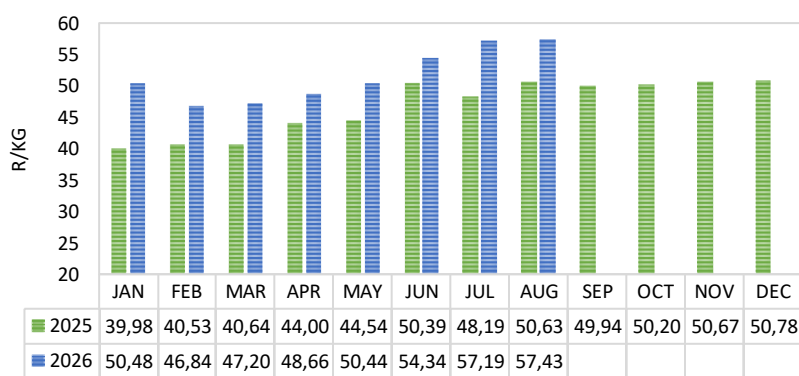
Class C2 / 3 Price trend

- In August 2026, the average price for Class C was R78,52 per kg, which is a 0,9% decrease when compared to July 2026.
- Year on year Class C prices increased by 2% in August 2026 compared to August 2025.

Storage Lamb Price trend

- In August 2026, the average price for Storage Lamb was R57,43 per kg, which is 0,4% higher than in July 2026.
- Year on year average prices in August 2026 were 13,4% higher than last year during the same period.
