

POULTRY MONTHLY REPORT



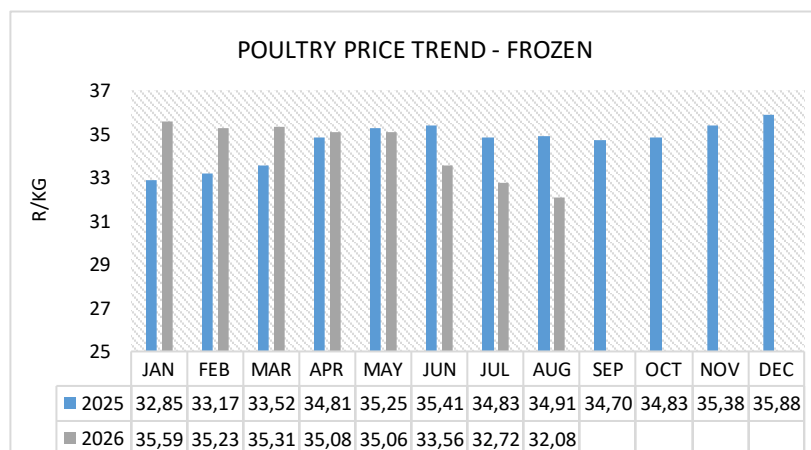
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This report provides price trends in the South African livestock market. It provides average monthly producer selling prices (R/kg) of poultry excluding value added tax.

Table 1: Poultry - Average monthly producer selling prices (excluding VAT) in R/kg.

In August 2026, average local poultry prices decreased from prices recorded in July 2026. When comparing year-year prices, there is a decrease in local poultry prices in August 2026 compared to the same period last year.

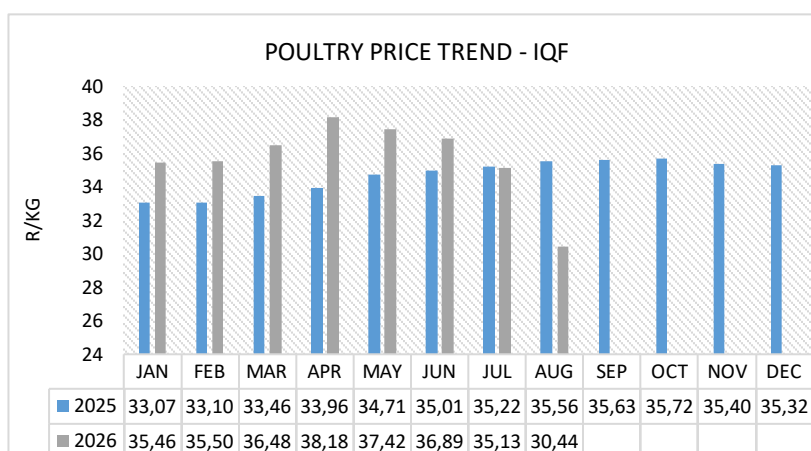
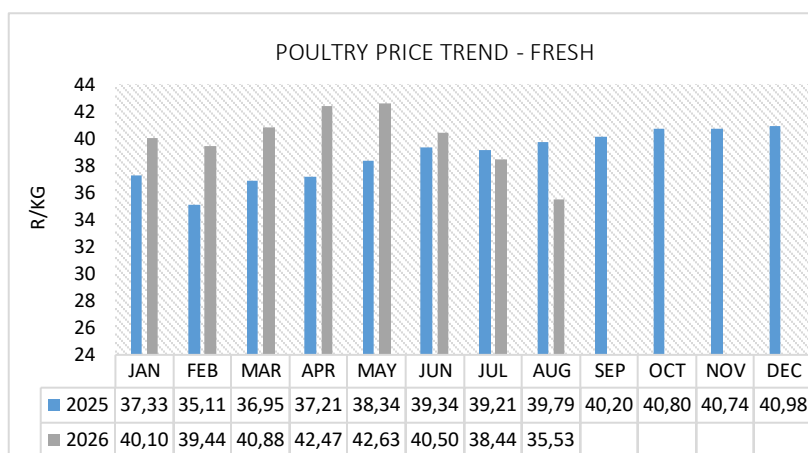


Frozen poultry price trend

- In August 2026, the average price for Frozen poultry was R32,08 per kg, which is 2% lower than in July 2026.
- Year on year average prices for Frozen poultry decreased by 8,1% in August 2026 compared to August 2025.

Fresh poultry price trend

- In August 2026, the average price for Fresh poultry was R35,53 per kg, which is 7,6% lower than in July 2026.
- Year on year average prices for Fresh poultry show a decrease of 10,7% between August 2025 and August 2026.



IQF poultry price trend

- In August 2026, the average price for IQF poultry was R30,44 per kg, which is a 13,4% price decrease from July 2026.
- Year on year IQF poultry showed a 14,4% average price decrease compared to same period last year.
